She was originally Princess of Wales from 1863 to 1902 and gave birth to 5 children. Her sixth and last pregnancy ended with the birth of a son in April 1872, but the infant died the next day. The death of her first-born son, Albert Victor in 1892 was a serious blow for Alexandra.

Alexandra died on November 20, 1925 in England and was buried on November 28.

One rule the queen imposed was that she did not allow any family member, not even her grandchildren, to have a mobile phone at the table where they were eating.
